The Chamberlin reproduces the true sounds of violins, flutes, cello, banjo, bassoon and many other instruments using best quality tapes, and the instruments can be played in single tones or chords.

The Chamberlin Company is the originator of tape playback musical instruments. The Chamberlin has been manufactured and used by musicians since 1952 and has been improved constantly. We now have a tape transport system that ends tape fouling, and the Chamberlin can be shipped in any position, on it's back, on it's side, on it's top, remove it from the carton or trunk and you can play immediately.

The tapes are long lasting as they only move when that particular key is pressed and a new tape can be changed in three minutes.

The exclusive tape transport system is patented and so simple that anyone can learn to service it in a short time. The Chamberlin has the most natural sounds, as each instrument is recorded with the best equipment and with the best musicians. It is the true sounds of any instrument because we take the entire note of that instrument and you play it back from the very start of the note on attack.

Take for example a guitar note, you hear the pick coming off of the string at the start and then hear the actual decay of each note.

The instruments are so accurately recorded that you can move your fingers rapidly up and down the keyboard and hear the start of every note.

A very novel effect is the natural sounds of male and female voices. You can have as many voices as you have fingers on the keys, and can make them sing any song in any key and as long as you wish.

The Chamberlin is small in size and light in weight, 80 lbs. The cabinet is made of hard finish formica walnut wood grain. We also can furnish shipping trunks.

The Chamberlin uses stereo heads under each key and two instruments can be blended together. Each instrument is controlled with a volume control and an on-off switch. Eight single instruments and six different instrument combinations can be played with a quick change selector while playing.

By adding the Chamberlin to your group you will have a big full sound to your music.
