At this year's MUSIK MESSE the new high-fidelity 'FAIRLIGHT CMI SERIES II X' will be demonstrated with its latest hardware and software innovations.

Peter Vogel, Director of Research and Development from Fairlight headquarters, will be on hand to answer any questions.

The SERIES II X is the expanded memory (500K RAM) version of the CMI. The Research and Development team is currently working on the first release of new software (available - April, 1984) which will take advantage of this additional memory capability. This will give the user the facility to run OS9 software, i.e. "off-the-shelf" accounting, spreadsheet and games packages, as well as high level languages.

April will also see the release of the new MIDI input/output, expanded Music Computer Language (MCL) storage and an increased number of controls and delayed vibrato.

Meanwhile, here in Frankfurt, the new CMI features on display include:

- * "STAVEWRITER" high-quality Music Notation Printer
- * Fourier Analysis
- * Wave-table voice synthesis
- * Back and forth looping in Mode 1
- * Pitch bend added to Page 7
- * Filter can be patched to control on Page 7
- * Waveform justification for pitch correction of sample sounds
- * Film Music Processor
